Singing Arrow Community Center

Singing Arrow Community Center (SACC) was established in the summer of 1995 as a "Shelter Center" because there weren't any permanent buildings therefore the gazebo at the south end of the park from which began a small neighborhood youth program was established.

Following it's success, space was provided by the Four Hills Shopping Center for the program to continue as an After School Recreation Program until the City Of Albuquerque was able to procure the necessary funds to purchase a double-wide barrack to place on the north side of the Singing Arrow park.

Though technically still called a Shelter Center, Singing Arrow has grown into three barracks combined with a brick and mortar building which connects the three and is now called Singing Arrow Community Center (SACC).

SACC continues to provide before and after school recreation for children ages 6 to 14. Child Development, a program for children 3 to 5 years old shares a space at the center , as well. During the
